



## Proper Process for Using MISC REF TEST Lab Code

Susquehanna Health has provided RVH&DC with a “generic lab code” to be used when no mapped code exists for a lab test that is being ordered by a Provider. **The use of this code is not to be used as a shortcut to “free-text” all lab orders and should be used with caution.** Although the results should come back through the interface, they will not be in a structured format and will simply appear as a narrative report.

To order this test you will need to utilize CPT Code **80196 MISC REF TEST**. In order to use the MISC REF TEST Code, it is required that the Provider/Clinical Support Staff document in the **Comments** section of the order to detail what lab test should be performed.
